## **General Reminders**

We have completed our **Letter Pocket activity** and we are finishing up our Alphabet Book with our **pre-k students** We will be binding your child's Alphabet Books and they should be ready to send home by the end of the month. Your child has worked so hard on this very special book I'm sure you will treasure it.

**Our color this month is PURPLE.** We have completed our discussion of shapes and are finishing up the colors this month. We will be putting together our yearlong Color and Shape Book to send home the beginning of June with our **preschool** students.

All returning students and/or siblings must submit updated registration forms. I will be sending home registration forms the week of 4/29. Please be sure when filling out the medical that your child has had or going to have before school begins, a complete physical. The form asks for the most recent physical information. Your child also is required to have a blood lead test upon entering preschool and a flu shot in the fall as well. I will be collecting proof of flu shots then. You may submit these forms over the summer or just before school starts on Wednesday September 4<sup>th</sup>. I am so excited to announce that all of our classes are full and we now have waiting lists for each class for the 2024-2025 school year.

We are just concerned for everyone's safety.

During the month of May, we will be finishing some yearlong projects with both age groups as well as some new activities. We still have lots of fun planned until the last day of classes. I will be evaluating each student again and you will receive another progress report by the beginning of June. I am sure you can see the progress your child has made this year! We are so proud of them!
